**I can add 2 to a number.**

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

$0+2=2$ $1+2=3$ $2+2=4$ $3+2=5$ $4+2=6$ $5+2=7$ $6+2=8$ $7+2=9$ $8+2=10$ $9+2=11$ $10+2=12$	They should also know the commutative calculations: (the other way round). $2+0=2$ $2+3=5$ $2+6=8$ $2+10=12$
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Key vocabulary</u></b> 8 add 2 equals 10 3 plus 2 is the same as 5 If I have 6, then I get 2 more, how many in total now?</p>
