Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians,

Below are the school dates for the Autumn Term 2024. You will also find this information on the calendar on our school website. Not all our dates have been set for this term yet and we will update the calendar as more events are arranged. We'll also keep you informed via the weekly newsletter which is emailed out on Fridays. These can also be found on our school website.

	g during the autumn term:
3 rd September	School reopens for our existing Nursery, direct entry Reception and Year One and Two children.
	During the first half term our Nursery children and those in Class 7 & 8 will be learning about
	Marvellous Me in My School. The children in Classes 1,2,3, & 5 will be learning about Me and
	My City. Initially, the teachers especially focus on: getting to know the children, settling them
	into school life and their new classes, establishing routines, and learning about class and school
	rules. This work is very important and time spent on this now pays dividend for the rest of the
	school year. There will be no formal English or Maths work during those first couple of weeks.
3 rd September	Each week our assemblies are based around a theme. This is shared with you via the
	newsletter each week. The theme for the first week is 'Welcome'.
4 th September	Our new Nursery children will be visiting for the remaining days of this week. They will start
	with us the week commencing 9 th September.
4 th September	Sally Hornsby, our Education Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP) starts back with us each
	Wednesday. Sally works with children who may need some additional support around their
	confidence, their worries etc. She is lovely and we're really glad she's working with us as she
	offers something different to our children. For the first few weeks, as we settle back in, she'll
	be working with each class around our Zones of Regulation . Zones of Regulation is a curriculum
	that supports children to identify emotions and develop strategies to cope with different ones.
4 th September	Mrs Taylor will be teaching Nursery each Wednesday.
6 th September	Teachers of classes 1,2,3, & 5 will be sending home introductory letters on Friday 6 th .
6 th September	Children in Classes 7 & 8 will earn Golden Time at the end of each day if they have succeeded in
	keeping our Golden rules. They vote each morning for their reward activity. Children in
	Classes 1,2,3, & 5 will enjoy Golden Time on a Friday afternoon each week. They sign up for
	their chosen activity at the beginning of each week.
9 th September	Our Reception children will be completing the statutory government baseline assessment over
	the next few weeks. You can find more information <u>here.</u>
9 th September	Our After School Clubs start this week.
9 th September	Mrs Bailey will begin teaching Classes this week to allow teachers their Planning, Preparation
	and Assessment (PPA) time. Details of this are shared each week on the newsletter and on our
	website. This half term the time will be organised as follows:

	Wednesday morning – Class 7

9 th September	Our Reading Volunteers start with us this week. These volunteers will work with our Y1 and Y2
	children initially. All the necessary checks and training have been carried out with and for our
	volunteers.
12 th September	9.00am. Mrs Townsend is available to show parents (current and new) around school. A one



















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	hour slot is offered most weeks. The times of these are also shared each week on the
	newsletter and are also on our website. Please contact the school office to 'book a slot'.
12 th September	Our Y2 children will begin drumming lessons today and each Thursday thereafter. There is no charge for these lessons.
15 th September	The 15 th September is International Dot Day. We are going to celebrate it in school on Friday 13 th September. Could can find out more about it <u>here</u> .
16 th September	We will begin our phonics lessons this week. We will share with you on the newsletter which phonemes (sounds), keywords and books the children will be learning and using. We require your support at home to practise these so that the children keep up with the pace of learning.
23 rd September	In liaison with Sheffield Local Authority, we are running some Start Well Sessions in school. Here are some of the things you will be able to get advice on: feeding, weaning and nutrition, dental care, mental health, physical health and why children's behaviour can be challenging. Colleagues will be able to offer support and strategies. Refreshments will be available. The sessions will take place in Class 6.
