IMPORTANT UPDATE - PLEASE READ – 'HAF CODE' REQUIRED FOR ALL SHEFFIELD HEALTHY HOLIDAY BOOKINGS!

Eligible families received a unique HAF code by letter earlier this year. Parents and carers will need their child's unique HAF code to book holiday activities either online or directly by phone/text/email with an activity provider.

Newly approved income-assessed/benefits-related free school meal applications will receive their HAF code via letter on or before Friday 29*th* November.

In cases where children are not eligible for benefits-related free school meals but are vulnerable in other ways, please direct parents to visit <u>www.sheffieldhealthyholidays.org</u> and search for activity providers under the area timetables to discuss access to the programme. Parents will need to contact the provider directly.

Please note, HAF providers may need to prioritise families eligible for benefits related free school meals if activities are oversubscribed.

Lost/misplaced HAF codes can be retrieved by completing an online form. The code will be emailed to eligible parents and carers within one working day.
